- **ALL SHEEP MUST HAVE CERTIFIED ID TAGS. NO EXCEPTIONS. ANIMALS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO UNLOAD IF ANIMAL DOES NOT BEAR AN APPROVED TAG.** [ALL EXHIBITORS SHOULD HAVE SPARE TAGS AVAILABLE. IF AN ANIMAL LOSES A TAG WHILE ON FAIRGROUNDS PROPERTY THE EXHIBITOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING AND ATTACHING THE REPLACEMENT TAG WITHIN TWO HOURS OF NOTIFICATION OF THE MISSING TAG OR THE ANIMAL WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS.](#)
- **ENTRY DEADLINE** - All animals in both Open & 4-H classes must be registered with the FAIR OFFICE by September 11, 2022, including class and tag number of each animal. All 4-H Member projects must be pre-registered by leaders, must have name, project and tag number to FAIR OFFICE by September 11, 2022. Livestock Registration forms are available on the Fair's website at www.rockcreekfallfair.ca/entry-forms OR use the **EASY ONLINE ENTRY SYSTEM** at www.assistexpo.ca/rcbfa (online entry system available on August 1st)
- Only one entry per Family in the Carcass Class **\$15.00 entry fee**. Only 6 spots available for this class. Call Duane at 250-446-2641 to reserve a spot.
- Open Classes – no more than 2 entries per class per exhibitor.
- Sheep entries will be accepted on Friday September 16, 2022 between 1:00 pm and 7:00 pm. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Sheep must be free of parasites and disease. All animals subject to health inspection. **Health inspection will take place on Friday, September 16, 2022, between 6:00 and 7:00 PM.** Failure to comply will result in disqualification of entire flock and the animals must be removed from the Fair Grounds.
- Open classes for all ages may be shown by Exhibitor on halter.
- Ewes shorn in current year and lambs tailed.
- Market lambs and Showmanship lambs must be trimmed to ½" – 1". 4-H Showmanship Classes – NO slicked sheered permitted.
- Any lambs born after January 1, 2019 must have tails docked between the 2nd and 3rd knuckle. If docked too short, owner will be asked to remove sheep from Fair Grounds.
- Carcass lambs may be shown in other classes but not required. Must be in presentable condition, clean of dirt etc.
- Carcass lambs do not have to be castrated.
- Processing of carcass sheep will be done by Magnum Meats.
- Rosette for Champion and Reserve Champion Classes.
- All Exhibitors must pay gate entrance fee.
- All Exhibitors must camp in designated areas and pay camping fees.
- Exhibits registered and exhibited in classes at the Fair must remain on Fair Premises until 4:30 PM on Sunday, September 18, 2022. Exhibits may not be pulled from classes or sold, unless authorized or mandated by Sheep Convenor.
