**Important Competitor Information: PLEASE READ – NEW RULES FOR 2019**

- **ALL LIVESTOCK MUST HAVE CERTIFIED ID TAGS. NO EXCEPTIONS. ANIMALS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO UNLOAD IF ANIMAL DOES NOT BEAR AN APPROVED TAG.**
- **ENTRY DEADLINE** - All animals in both Open & 4-H classes must be registered with the FAIR OFFICE by September 6, 2019, including class and tag number of each animal. All 4-H Member projects must be pre-registered by leaders, must have name, project and tag number to FAIR OFFICE by September 6, 2019. Livestock Registration forms are available on the Fair's website at [www.rockcreekfallfair.ca/entry-forms](http://www.rockcreekfallfair.ca/entry-forms)
- Participants are also required to complete an Exhibitor Entry Form and submit it to the Fair Office prior to September 6, 2019. Exhibitor Entry Forms are available on the Fair's website at [www.rockcreekfallfair.ca/entry-forms](http://www.rockcreekfallfair.ca/entry-forms)
- **Livestock entries will be accepted on Friday September 13, 2019 between 1:00 pm and 7:00 pm. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Livestock must be free of parasites and disease. All animals subject to health inspection. **Health inspection will take place on Friday, September 13, 2019, between 6:00 and 7:00 PM.** Failure to comply will result in disqualification and animal must be removed from the Fair Grounds.
- Only one entry per Family in the Carcass Class
- Night ties are required for yearlings and older animals
- Nose rings are **MANDATORY** for bulls.
- Name signs must be posted for all animals and include owner's name, breed, weight and tag #.
- ALL CLASSES: If more than 9 entries, will be divided into two classes and will enter the ring by age, youngest to oldest.
- All Exhibitors must pay gate entrance fee.
- All Exhibitors must camp in designated areas and pay camping fees.
- Exhibits registered and exhibited in classes at the Fair must remain on Fair Premises until 4:00 pm on Sunday, September 15, 2019. Exhibits may not be pulled from classes or sold, unless authorized or mandated by Beef Convenor.

## BEEF CLASSES

### Three-year Challenge Special

Rules: Duration to be three consecutive Fairs. Program begins with the entry and showing of heifer calves born in current year. Entries return the following year as yearlings, and the year after with calves at side. Each year, entries will be judged (scored) by a panel consisting of the Beef Judge and two other judges. Scores to be posted after each section is completed. Enrolled animals will be eligible to enter all other regular classes. A one-time entry fee of \$25/head, will be divided 50%, 30%, 20% among their year winners. If only one or two complete the three years, they divide the purse.

**B01-A** Three Year Challenge – Heifer Calf born in 2019

**Prizes:** \$75, \$45, \$30

**B02** Calf, Female, born in 2019

**B01-B** Three Year Challenge – Yearling Heifer entered previous year

**B04-A** 4-H Cow/Calf Project

**Prizes:** \$100, \$50, \$35, \$25, \$15

**B05** Calf – Bull, born in 2019

**Prizes:** \$100, \$75, \$40, \$30, \$20

**B05-A** Yearling Bull

**Prizes:** \$100, \$75, \$40, \$30, \$20

**B06** Get of Sire – 3 animals by one sire, any age (not necessarily bred or owned by exhibitor)

**Prizes:** \$70, \$60, \$50, \$40

**B07** Breeder's Herd – 1 cow & calf, 1 yearling heifer, and 1 bull any age, shown in previous classes

**Prizes:** \$100, \$75, \$30, \$20

**B08** Prospect Steer Calf born in 2019

**Prizes:** \$75, \$45, \$30, \$20, \$10

**B09** McMynn Open Steer – Grain fed, open single market finished steer. There may be 2-3 heats prior to the Championship placings.

**Prizes:** \$280, \$240, \$180, \$140, \$100, \$60

**B10** 4-H Yearling Steer – Steer will be divided into weight classes. Steer in this class are not eligible to enter McMynn Open Steer or Carcass Special classes.

**Prizes:** \$50, \$35, \$25, \$5 to all other placings

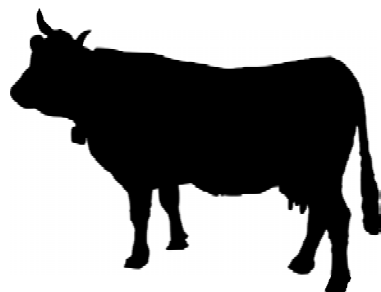

**B11** 4-H Home Grown Steer – Must be born and raised on Exhibitor's Farm

**Prizes:** \$50, \$35, \$25, \$5 to all other placings

**B12-A** Pen of Two Heifers – Two yearling heifers from one contributor to be penned together at Fair. A panel of 3 Judges will judge on Saturday afternoon. No clipping or washing of cattle at Fair Grounds. Cattle do not need to be halter broke but must be gentle. Unruly cattle will be refused. Limit to ten pairs.

**B12-B** 2018 Pen of Two Heifers can be exhibited in 2019 with calves at side.
