**INFORMATION TO HELP YOU ENJOY OUR FAIR
MOST IMPORTANT BE KIND & PATIENT!!**

**Please remember we have many volunteers working on site so be considerate of this and
remember they are not the ones who make the rules & are only following directions!**

FAIR GATE TICKET PURCHASE – You can enter our fair at the main ticket booth gate, the livestock gate ticket booth & through the Blaine Memorial Campground where a secondary ticket booth is located. You must have your hand stamped for same day re-entry.

AMUSEMENT RIDES – tickets are purchased at the Shooting Star Amusements ticket booth

SHUTTLE BUS—There is a free shuttle bus that does pickups outside the main gate & does drop offs at the various parking locations and will be running throughout both days!

FIRST AID – we have trained medical personnel on site in the first aid booth. BC Ambulance will also be on site throughout the weekend at main gate, unless they get a callout. **If it is a medical emergency call 911**

LOST CHILDREN – If you cannot locate your child, proceed to the red Information building by stage. Please help us by showing your children where to go if they are lost & remind them not to hide. Consider writing your cell # on their arm & take a current picture of your child on your phone.

SECURITY – Licensed security guards will be onsite Thursday, Friday & Saturday night at the Blaine Memorial Campground & Wilderness campground and patrolling throughout grounds. There will be zero tolerance for partying and excess noise!

SAFETY PERSONNEL- we will also have volunteer safety members on site day & night throughout the weekend patrolling various areas.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS – we are not responsible for any damage or theft of your belongings

KIDZONE AREA - a fun shaded area for children to play. **DO NOT** leave your children unattended at any time on fairgrounds.

WATER BOTTLE REFILL STATION – located on outside of booth just past pavilion towards the barns

OUTSIDE FOOD & BEVERAGES – you are welcome to bring your own food to help cut expenses

ATM – located inside main pavilion by the office

WASHROOMS – Indoor washrooms located inside pavilion & Blaine Memorial Campground.

Portable toilets are located at end of the vendor field (ball diamond) and another set are located at the east end of grounds near arena & barns, just past the Kid Zone. A pit toilet is also located in lower parking area, far end near wilderness camping and another is located in the Blaine Memorial Campground.

SMOKING is permitted only in smoking area at the end of vendor field, ball diamond dugouts.

NO DRUGS & ALCOHOL: alcohol is only permitted in the beer garden. No drug use of any kind!

Food Vendors - there are food vendors scattered about our grounds for your convenience.

Artisan Farmers Market vendors – be sure to pop into the white picket fence to see these extra vendors. Including a winery & distillery, however open liquor is not permitted on the fairgrounds, so do not open your purchase until you get home.

Vendor Village – we have a variety of excellent vendors for your educational & shopping experience so be sure to check them out! More education vendors are located inside the pavilion.

Exhibits & Display's – are showcased in the Pavilion and the Agriculture building. The exhibits can be picked up on Sunday between 5:00-6:00pm, however no vehicles will be permitted into the parking lot until after 6:00pm.

Livestock & Poultry Barn – the barns are located east end of our grounds near the arena, just past pavilion. We ask you not pet the animals without permission of the owners.

NO PETS - pets are not permitted on the grounds or in Blaine Memorial campground, unless they are part of the entertainment or certified service dogs, please bring your certification as you may be asked to show it. They are permitted in Wilderness campground. Do not leave Pets in your vehicles!
